Broome Speedway Club advises that ALL COMPETITORS wishing to race at Broome Speedway are required to hold a valid Speedway Australia licence for the division they will compete in.

All infringement cards and log books to be handed into the Race Secretary and held by the Chief Steward during the duration of the meeting, after your vehicle has been scrutineered.

Drivers Agreement

I agree to be bound by the rules and regulations of the Broome Speedway Club and all decisions made by the appointed committee. I also understand;

- That it is a condition of entry that all Drivers and Persons in the pit area must have insurance.
- Competitors are responsible for their pit crew's actions.
- All persons entering the pits **MUST** wear enclosed shoes. Smoking only permitted in designated areas. **NO** alcohol in pit area.
- One Way Communicators must be worn whilst racing or automatic disqualification.
- Scrutineering will take place at the track from 2.00pm.
- Log book and insurance cards must be presented.
- Drivers Briefing will be held at 4pm at the Pit Box.
- Racing commences at 5pm.
- **My car meets the BSC NMP noise limit of 90 DB (up to 6Cyl) or 95Db (V8) and has been tested as such. Please note you will be tested if your vehicle is deemed loud and will be excluded from event if not rectified.**
